


September, 2021

Candidate Support Committee Update: The executive committee voted last month to publicly endorse Tracy Davidson and Kristy Meyer (Westerville School Board) and Melanie Farkas (Liberty Township Trustee), and ten additional candidates were given financial support. These candidates need much more than our endorsement or money--they need YOU! They need help with filling out postcards, delivering door hangers and reaching out to them. Give them a call today to see what they need. Being active in our local elections gains attention of those in next year's Senate and Representative elections. Let's do this!

**Delaware-Morrow Mental Health Levy:** The Delaware-Morrow Mental Health & Recovery Services Board has placed a levy on the Nov. 2 ballot. The Board is asking voters to support a renewal of its current one mill property tax with an additional 0.5 mill, bringing the new total to 1.5 mills. This would cost homeowners \$41.56 for each \$100,000 of property value. The organization funds behavioral health programs and services in Delaware and Morrow Counties and these levy funds will account for about 80% of their revenue for the year. Our Executive Committee will vote on whether to endorse this levy at our October meeting. Read more about the levy <a href="here">here</a>.
