Thank you to our candidates for county and state legislative offices, and to all who turned in petitions for Central Committee positions. The Candidate Support Committee will be interviewing our County Candidates this month, and they are providing lots of support to these brave new people.

The Ohio Democratic Party's free training program, Main Street Initiative 2022, is launching the 2022 program in collaboration with LEAD Ohio. #### **Volunteer Opportunities**

We're looking for a Party Secretary. One of five Party Officers, the Secretary plays an important role in addition to recording minutes of our meetings and writing them up. We are required to provide certain official notices to the public and report to the Secretary of State who our Officers are, including all those on our Executive Committee. If you would like to have a test run, volunteer to take minutes and write them up for our April meeting. This officer position will be voted on during our reorganization meeting that happens shortly after the Primary. If two people would like to share this responsibility, that is also an option.

Next, our communications coordinates and manages what goes out to our members and friends, as well as messages that come in from members, friends, the press, and the general public. Our communication channels include our <a href="website">website</a>, <a href="Facebook page">Facebook page</a>, <a href="Twitter">Twitter</a>, this newsletter, and email. We promote DCDP and progressive values, pass along news items, and always try to maintain a positive presence on social media. Right now, we need a volunteer to handle our Instagram account. Lastly, is our Data position. This is a never-ending job that includes accounting for who is a supporting member, who is a member of the Executive Committee, who is a precinct rep, and

who subscribes to party emails. We also keep track of the street addresses of our email subscribers, so that we can target emails geographically when we need to.

#### **Paid Staff**

Many 2022 candidates are hiring paid staff, and you can contact them using information on our <u>party website</u>. The Ohio Democratic Party is also still hiring additional staff to work throughout the state, jobs are on <u>their website</u>. Locally, the Delaware County <u>Board of Elections</u> is hiring poll workers and seasonal office staff, and has special opportunities for attorneys and social workers as well.
