We will work together with the Ohio Democratic Party to support all of our Democratic candidates, from the national level, statewide and state legislative, as well as here in Delaware County. Our party is organized geographically by region as well as having several committees that focus on specific party work.

As we anticipate a second Primary and move closer to the General Election in November, we will need more volunteers. There are opportunities both behind the scenes and working directly with campaigns and voters. Active committees put in many hours and report each month to our Executive Committee. Party Organization in early June

We expect the Board of Elections to certify the results of the first Primary on May 24, and then those elected to the Central Committee of the Delaware County Democratic Party will meet to organize the party anew. We will elect five officers, and follow other procedures contained in our new Constitution and By-Laws. At this time, we do not have a candidate for party Treasurer. This is a never-ending job that includes accounting for who is a supporting member, who is a member of the Executive Committee, and who subscribes to party emails. Not to mention keeping up with phone, address and email changes.

Precinct & Regional Organization & Development (PROD)

With the first part of the Primary completed, we can see that there is work to be done to increase Democratic voter turnout. While overall voter turnout in Ohio compares favorably to the last three gubernatorial primaries, this year Republican voters in Delaware County outnumbered Democrats 3 to 1. We will be working on getting regions and precincts better trained and organized to reach out to the Democratic voters in their areas and getting them OUT to vote.

Each of the 167 precincts in Delaware County has been assigned to one of six regions. The coordinators for each region are listed below. If you are not sure what region you live in, please call our party phone number, **(614) 259-8020**.

Before the second part of our Primary this year, Precinct Reps will be getting training in how to reach out to Democrats in your neighborhood to encourage voting. We will again prepare and post a **printable Slate Card** with Democratic candidates on our website. Encourage your neighbors to request Absentee Ballots NOW!

Poll Workers are needed for the next Primary and the General Election in November - these are paid positions, and so important. Contact <u>Rob</u> at the Board of Elections or call (740) 833-2080. The Ohio Democratic Party is also still hiring. See their <u>website</u>.

In order to increase our party's visibility in the community, it is important that Democrats are seen serving on **various county boards**. Most of these are unpaid, volunteer positions, but they are very important and can sometimes lead to bigger opportunities.
