ODP Family Reunion 2022

On Friday evening, July 15, the Ohio Democratic Party (ODP) is hosting its first in-person, large-scale event in over two years. The 2022 Family Reunion features Senator Sherrod Brown, Congressman and US Senate Nominee Tim Ryan, Gubernatorial Nominee Nan Whaley, Congresswoman Joyce Beatty, and Democrats from all over Ohio. The main event will be held at Kemba Live! at 405 Neil Ave in Columbus, and there will be an after party next door at A&R Bar (391 Neil) following the program. Doors open at 5:30 p.m. and the program starts at 6:30.

Delaware County has a tradition of being well represented at statewide events such as this. We are reserving 3 blocks of ten tickets as a start, and could get more if needed. At this time, we are offering tickets through our party at a **discount**, as long as they are available. Best to reserve your spot now! When our county party purchases a block of 10 General Admission Tickets, each individual ticket will only be \$75.
