Volunteer Opportunities

You can get involved: Visit <u>our party website</u> to get started on opportunities to serve. Volunteers are staffing our temporary campaign office on North Sandusky Street in Delaware, writing postcards, delivering yard signs, and serving as <u>Precinct Elections Officials</u>. We will also need many volunteers to hand out slate cards at the Early Vote Center and on Election Day.

Stop in to our campaign headquarters, **18 N Sandusky Street in Delaware** to pick up yard signs and/or information about candidates! If that is not convenient, you can request yard signs at <u>www.ohiodeladems.org</u>

As we head into the final stretch of the 2022 General Election, we are pleased to welcome Said Haji, of Westerville as our Delaware County Field Organizer from the Coordinated Campaign. Said (pronounced sah-EED) has met several of our county party and regional leaders, and will be providing us with "turf" to walk our neighborhoods and distribute campaign literature. We plan to hold <u>canvas events</u> every weekend until November 8.

Starting this weekend, ODP will mail sample ballots (slate cards) to more than 56,000 voters in Delaware County. Our state party will also create a digital version which will be available on social media, and ODP will text voters, asking them to text the word "BALLOT" to access the specific digital sample ballot for their home county. Our Delaware County website includes a listing of upcoming events and all of our candidates, with their websites, as well as a <u>printable option</u>.

Boosting Democratic Voter Turnout: Our precinct reps have already been working on connecting with Democrats in their neighborhoods to improve turnout of Democratic voters, and to let them know that they are available to help with any election related questions.
