Delaware County Democratic PartyRobert E. Parker Scholarship Fund

Each spring the Delaware County Democratic Party gives scholarships to graduating seniors at area high schools in the county who plan to continue their schooling at the collegiate level. Additional points may be awarded for presentation and completeness.

- 3. Grade Point Average (GPA) and the most recent transcript:

- 5. A resume that outlines the student's extracurricular and community activities and work experience:
- 6. A <u>maximum</u> 500-word essay that outlines and explores involvement in community volunteer programs, political advocacy, extracurricular activities, and work that supports the social issues identified above:
- 7. A <u>maximum</u> 250-word essay explaining the student's ambitions and goals for the future and proposed areas of study.
